Recommended Feline Vaccination Schedule

Kittens- It is recommended that kittens receive their first **FVRCP** at 6-9 weeks of age.

FVRCP stands for

Feline Rhinotrachetitis and Calicivirus

Panleukopenia

Chlamvdia

Kittens need to continue to receive these vaccines **every 3-4 weeks** for a **series of 3 sets**. The following is the schedule of what each kitten will get at each of the 3 visits.

**1st VISIT (6-9 Weeks) **

Complete Physical Exam
Feline Leukemia/Feline Immunodeficiency Test
FVRCP Vaccine
Fecal Analysis and Deworming

**2nd VISIT (9-13 Weeks) **

FVRCP Booster Feline Leukemia Vaccine Begin Flea & Tick Prevention

**3rd VISIT (13-16 weeks) **

FVRCP Booster
Feline Leukemia Vaccine
1 yr. Rabies Vaccine
Schedule Spay or Neuter for 6 months of age

*** KITTENS starting at 4-6 MONTHS OLD will start at the 2ND Visit. KITTENS starting after 6 MONTHS OLD will start at the 3RD Visit.***
